DIRECTIONS TO ROXBURY CENTER FOR ARTS AT HIBERNIAN HALL

184 Dudley Street, Roxbury, MA 02119 617-541-3900

The Roxbury Center for Arts can be easily reached by public transportation or by car and there is plenty of free parking. The hall is accessible by elevator from the front (184 Dudley Street) or rear (Ziegler St. off of Harrison Ave.).

FROM THE NORTH OR SOUTH SHORE (ROUTE 93/SOUTHEAST EXPRESSWAY)

On Rt. 93 (N or S), take exit 18 (Mass Ave. /Roxbury or Frontage Road).

Follow signs toward Mass. Ave./Roxbury to intersection with Mass. Ave.

Go straight onto Melnea Cass Blvd. (large overhead sign).

At third light after Mass. Ave., turn left onto Harrison Ave. (Morgan Memorial – no street sign).

Follow directions and parking instructions under Parking.

FROM RT. 9 (JUST BEFORE THE MFA IF TRAVELING EAST, JUST AFTER IT IF TRAVELING WEST)

Turn right (left if traveling West) onto Ruggles St. (Wentworth Institute of Technology).

Follow Ruggles to Tremont St. and turn left.

Shortly afterward, turn right onto Melnea Cass Blvd.

Follow Melnea Cass several blocks until you get to Harrison Ave. (Morgan Memorial).

Turn right onto Harrison Ave.

Follow directions and parking instructions under Parking.

FROM CAMBRIDGE

Take Mass. Ave. Bridge to Boston.

Follow Mass. Ave. to Harrison Ave. in the South End.

Turn right onto Harrison Ave.

Follow directions and parking instructions under Parking.

BY MBTA

The Silver line (bus) will bring you to Dudley Station.

Walk out to Dudley St. (1 block) and turn left.

Roxbury Center for Arts is on your left next to the Fire Station just after you cross Harrison Ave.

PARKING

Behind the hall:

A few blocks down Harrison, turn left onto Ziegler St.

Roxbury Center for Arts is the second building on the right.

Park behind building or if lot is full, drop passengers off and park either on street or in city lot.

City Lot:

On Harrison Ave. (just before Ziegler St.) there is a free city lot on your right (black fence).

After you park, cross Harrison Ave., and walk to your right down Harrison Ave. to Ziegler St.

Turn left onto Ziegler. The back entrance to the hall is the second building on the right.

Street parking:

There is free parking on Ziegler and other surrounding streets.
